### **NEW! O Scale Coal Cart Kit**

A coal cart kit based on the carts used in the maritime industry and often seen in old photographs lined up along side passenger steam ships. Should work nicely for coal, ash, trash, ore or anything else you can think of. Bucket is removable, so just add 3 small chains to the bucket for a small derrick to load coal into a tender! Retail price per cart kit (O-401-A) **\$8.95.**

### **NEW! O Scale Fish Cart Kit.**

This cart is typical of the fish carts that were used by the fishing industry and often seen in old photographs on the wharfs next to fishing schooners in Boston and other New England ports. They were often lined up with the handles parked under the next cart's wheel and loaded up with cod for markets and deliveries. Kit includes laser cut parts

and brass rod and comes in three versions: Single Cart (O-400-A) for **\$5.95**; Single Cart with Fish Crates (O-400-C) for **\$8.95** (pictured); and 4 Pack of Fish Carts (O-400-B) for **\$19.95.** For sale on website.



### **NEW! O Scale WW&F Crossing Signs.**

This small railroad crossing sign measures 1 7/8" tall by 1 1/2" wide and is modeled after the signs used by the WW&F and is still used by the WW&F Museum. Standard practice is to use one sign per crossing, posted to the right as you approach the track. This kit is made from laser cut wood with paper lettering. Kit builds four narrow gauge

crossing signs. Retail price per kit (O-500) **\$2.95.**
